Overview:

 shall be fabricated and supplied to meet all statutory requirements, codes of practice and applicable
 specifications.

 scope of work includes not only the foregoing, but may include at EMCP's discretion, future work related to
 minor changes to the scope of work described herein, in which EMCP may engage offshore Newfoundland
 and Labrador, for oil and gas facilities as well as exploration or subsea related activities.
- While not planned, it should be noted that the resulting RFP and Agreement may require inclusion of and/or
 extension to other operators in the area, project co-venturers, suppliers and/or affiliated companies.
- For work related to the Hebron Project, EMCP supports providing opportunities to Canadian, and, in particular, Newfoundland and Labrador companies and individuals, on a commercially competitive basis. Suppliers expressing interest in providing services or materials, if they are selected to bid, will be required to complete a Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Benefits Questionnaire at the bid stage.

Scope of Work Overview:

Anticipated to commence September 8th, 2023, Hebron Production Platform will undergo a turnaround period to complete the internal inspection of multiple Hydrocarbon Process Vessels. The key enabler to inspect these process vessels is to rid the Process and Vessels of Hydrocarbons. This scope of work for this expression of interest is limited to turnaround duration and is expected to provide the following objectives:

- Provide industrial steam cleaning services with all required certifications to be utilized for removal of hydrocarbons from offshore process vessels, piping, and other pressure retaining equipment.
 - Methodology to be such that confined space entry is not required to clean process vessels or to remove hydrocarbons.
- Provide all equipment and material needed to perform steam cleaning. This includes but not limited to:
 - o Boiler(s)
 - Hosing
 - o Pumps
 - o Effluent Management Equipment
- Provide full suite of project management and technical support required to deliver services. This includes but is not limited to:
 - o Procedure development detailing cleaning process. Includes annotated/marked-up drawings showing connections to platform equipment and piping.
 - o Timeline/schedule estimates.
 - Any required training for platform operations personnel required to be able to effectively support steam cleaning.
 - o Technical liaise with platform operations team to provide recommendations on injection points, effluents contents, etc.
- Supply personnel to execute scope in field. Personnel will be required to travel offshore and pass all pre-job training/screenings.

Additionally, the selected supplier will be required to meet all technical and Safety, Security, Health, and Environmental (SSHE) specifications and safe work practices of EMCP and its affiliates as appropriate.

Minimum Technical Requirements

- Effectively demonstrate that proposed cleaning process can remove hydrocarbons from equipment without confined space entry (or with minimal confined space entry).
- Any chemicals or additives used in process must have a valid SDS for review.
- Supplier must provide material compatibility details of any chemicals used in steam cleaning process.
- All equipment must be able to transport offshore via vessel and can be utilized in an offshore environment.
- Ability to provide client with estimates of required utilities, required chemical needs and effluent quantities.
- Should have the technical ability to respond to platform operations queries on the steam cleaning process, as well as provide guidance to operations to maximize steam cleaning results.

Must have the technical ability to manage effluent effectively.

Submission Requirements

Supplier submissions in response to this Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification) **must** include the afore-mentioned reference number, as well as the following information:

Describe your experience operating under and familiarity with, the benefits provisions of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Act, and your experience with any similar regimes in other parts of Canada or internationally. At the NRFP/ITT stage, bidders will be required to indicate how they comply with the above.
- 7. Please acknowledge that responsible management personnel have read, understand and will support requirements to comply with the following where applicable
 - i. Section 45 of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Act
 - ii. The Hebron Benefits Agreement and Hebron Benefits Plan
- 8. Submitted information is to be provided in separate PDF (or native file) submissions and not submitted as one combined file. Please be aware that Company is limited to a 10MB file size for receiving e-mail.
