Scope of Work Overview:

Drilling & Completions Overview:

- The Hebron Development will be comprised of five pools, three of which are targeted for resource depletion in the initial development and one that has been designated for potential storage of excess gas generated from production operations.
- Platform wellbores will have three-dimensional trajectories with long horizontal sections requiring extended reach drilling (ERD) profiles.
- Project will consist of:
 - Oil Producer wellbores with open hole screen co mpletions and gas lift co mpletion designs with downhole chemical injection
 - o Water injection wellbores with either cased hole or open hole screen completions
 - o Gas injection wellbores with either cased or open hole screen completions
- Primary consideration for material selection includes the anticipated evolution of H₂S and its effect on the gas lift system as well as the potential for condensation within the production casing annuli (wet, sour gas in annulus for gas lifted producers)
- Further detail on well envi ronment and loading conditions as well as quality requirements will be provided in technical scope of work in the bid phase.

The scope of work/supply includes, but is not limited to:

- Supply, operation, and maintenance of well completion equipment, facilities for the pre-assembly, maintenance and testing of completion components.
- Provision of qualified o nshore and offshore personnel to co ordinate and conduct tec hnical and operational (deployment) activities;
- Participation in the planning and design of all wells, completions, and well workovers in accordance with the contract scope;
- Company requires that Contractor will provide complete suite of upper completion components for the variety of well types, including but not limited to the following:
 - Tubing Retrievable Surface Controlled Subsurface Safety Valve (TRSCSSV)
 - c/w internal accessories (sleeves), control line and clamps
 - Downhole Pressure Temperature Gauge (DHPTG)
 - c/w control line and clamps and surface data collection units
 - Formation Isolation Valve (FIV)

- To be placed in lower completion to isolate open hole wellbore below during upper completion installation.
- Downhole chemical injection mandrels as required
 - c/w downhole chemical injection lines as required
- Production Packer / PBR assemblies
- Gas Lift Mandrels & Valves
- Annular Safety Valves (ASV) complete with required control lines and clamps
- Cross-coupling and mid-joint clamps as required to suit the various completion designs for the project
- Various assortment of plugs, and nipple profiles as required
- Completions to be installed in either:
 - Singular 9-5/8" production casing
 - Tapered 10-3/4" x 9-5/8" production casing
- Completion size to vary between 5-1/2" and 7" tubing depending on well requirements. (5-1/2" completion assemblies may be required to comply with 9-5/8" production casing design)
- Gravel Pack Service tools including gr avel pack packer capable of serving as long term production packer.

Additionally, the selected contractor will be required to meet all technical and Safety, Health, Environmental, and Security (SHE&S) specifications and safe work practices of ExxonMobil its affiliates as appropriate.

At the RFP/ITT stage, bidders will be required to indicate how they comply with the above.

 - ii) The Hebron Benefits Agreement and Hebron Benefits Plan work requirements
