

## Supply of Hebron Equipment Strategies Development

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### **Overview:**

- ExxonMobil Canada Properties, a partnership (ExxonMobil) is in the process of pre-qualifying companies who can develop Equipment Strategies for the Hebron Project.
- The intention is to have this scope of work cover the requirements of the Hebron Project. While not planned, it should be noted that the resulting contract may require inclusion of and/or extension to other operators in the area, project co-venturers, contractors and/or affiliated companies.
- For work related to the Hebron Project, ExxonMobil supports providing opportunities to Canadian, and, in particular, Newfoundland and Labrador companies and individuals, on a commercially competitive basis. Contractors expressing interest in providing services or materials, if they are selected to bid, will be required to complete a Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Benefits Questionnaire at the bid stage.
- ExxonMobil Canada Properties, a partnership (ExxonMobil) encourages the participation of members of designated groups (women; Aboriginal peoples; persons with disabilities; and members of visible minorities) and corporations or cooperatives owned by them, in the supply of goods and services.

### **Scope of Work Overview:**

The scope of work/supply includes but is not limited to:

- Configuration of Meridium Equipment Strategies Database, loading equipment tags, and loading necessary equipment data
- Equipment Criticality Assessment (SHE and Financial), including identification of Top Tier Equipment
- Development and assignment of Equipment Strategies or maintenance tasks which meet Operations Integrity Management System (OIMS), Facilities Integrity Management System (FIMS), Maintenance & Reliability (M&R), and local regulatory requirements.

The following areas and equipment are within the scope of the Equipment Strategies Development Plan:

- Topsides equipment and structures excluding Drilling
- Gravity Based Structure (GBS)
- Offshore Loading System (OLS)
- Subsea Equipment

Additionally, the selected contractor will be required to meet all technical and Safety, Health, Environmental, and Security (SHE&S) specifications and safe work practices of ExxonMobil and its affiliates as appropriate.

## **Minimum Technical Requirements**

- Knowledge of ExxonMobil Equipment Strategies Processes and Best Practices and prior experience with ExxonMobil Greenfield projects preferred
- Experience with Meridium Equipment Strategies Database
- Experience developing equipment strategies for major greenfield projects
- Subject matter expertise for integrity programs in the following areas:
  - Corrosion Control & Chemical Injection, Pressure Equipment, Pipeline, Structural Equipment, Machinery, Subsea Equipment, Marine Systems, Critical Instrumentation Controls & Alarms, Electrical Systems, Cranes and Lifting Gear, Emergency Communications, Security Fire Fighting Equipment, Oil Spill Response Equipment, Safety Equipment

## **Submission Requirements**

Vendor submissions in response to this Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification) **must** include the afore-mentioned reference number as well as the following information:

1. Completed ExxonMobil Vendor SHE pre-qualification questionnaire. (Available through BIDS – see contact information below.)
2. Information demonstrating qualification for the Scope of Work detailed above.
3. Information demonstrating vendor can meet minimum technical requirements detailed above.
4. Completed technical questionnaire. (Available through BIDS – see contact information below.)
5. Completed Supplier Capability Survey. (Available through BIDS – see contact information below.)
6. Describe your experience operating under and familiarity with, the benefits provisions of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Acts and your experience with any similar regimes in other parts of Canada or internationally. At the RFP/ITT stage, Bidders will be required to indicate how they comply with the above.
7. Please acknowledge that responsible management personnel have read, understand and will support requirements to comply with the following:
  - a. Section 45 of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Acts

The data submitted in response to the aforementioned questionnaires will be used to evaluate your company's ability (and those of your preferred sub-contractors / vendors where applicable) to perform these services or provide these materials. It will focus primarily on:

- applicable experiences
- project execution skills
- project management skills & integration skills
- available technologies with proven performance
- current capability
- work-load
- personnel qualifications

We will evaluate this data and develop a final group of vendors who will be asked to submit formal competitive bids. We reserve the right to make the final determination of which contractors will receive the Invitation to Tender (ITT) and which contractor will be awarded the final contract.

This Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification) is not a pre-qualification of contractors for other ExxonMobil work but is limited to the scope aforementioned. In addition, participation in this Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification), including any statements whether oral or written between ExxonMobil and your company shall not create or be deemed to create any binding legal relationship or contract, or be construed to do so between ExxonMobil and your company. All costs associated with the preparation of your response to this expression of interest shall be at your expense.

Finally, it should be clearly understood that this Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification) may or may not result in the issuance of an ITT and may or may not result in the award of a contract. Further, it should be clearly understood that if you respond to this Expression of Interest (including pre-qualification) and your company is selected to be on the bidders list that your company name and contact information may be posted on public websites. Similarly, if you are selected for award, the same information may also be posted indicating that the work has been awarded to your company.
